

## RoHS Certificate of Compliance

Restriction of the use of certain Hazardous Substances (RoHS)

Our ref : FBA20095

EU Directive 2011/65/EU and Commission Delegated Directive (EU) 2015/863 ("RoHS Directive") restricts the use of the hazardous substances listed below in electrical and electronic equipment.

Based on information provided by our suppliers or NEC's own investigations, NEC designates the products listed below for orders placed on or after the date of this certificate ("Products") as **RoHS compliant**.

**RoHS compliant** means that:

- Our supplier has confirmed the compliance status of component parts for the Products to us;
- We have implemented certain processes to confirm and document this; and
- We perform material content testing of the component parts, if necessary.

Confirmation of compliance status by our suppliers is either because the products do not contain any of the restricted substances referred to in Article 4(1) of the RoHS Directive at concentrations in excess of those permitted under the RoHS Directive or the removal of the restricted substances is not technically possible and their existence in the products at levels in excess of these concentrations is allowed as one of the particular applications listed in the Annex to the RoHS Directive.

NEC has taken the steps stated above to confirm suppliers' statements regarding the absence of the restricted substances and maintains a reasonable audit trail of relevant documentation to support this.
